Associazione Diplomatici, an NGO in consultative status with ECOSOC, sponsors the Change the World Model United Nations (CWMUN) to convey to young people the sense of belonging to today's global society, to bring forth their sense of responsibility towards the issues that affect our planet, and train them to encourage their concrete commitment as leaders and thinkers of tomorrow.



The concept standing behind CWMUN directly reflects Diplomatici's global engagement pursued through educational means:

- Change the World MUN revolves around a specific theme that is developed on the most compelling international issues (global warming and climate change, water scarcity and sanitation, peace and security, human rights, world hunger and poverty, social and economic development, globalization, etc.). A different theme is chosen every year and it constitutes the main topic of the whole conference, which is one of the features that makes CWMUN unique of its kind!
- Accurately reproducing the actual working procedures of the major UN multilateral bodies, CWMUN allows participants to take on the role of ambassadors to the UN, representing the viewpoint of a single Member State or a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) within several different committees. During the conference, students from different countries cooperate to build concrete proposals, negotiate to reach consensus, and eventually pass resolutions that represent the results of an intercultural creative process addressed to face our world's most pressing troubles.

FAO ENTRANCE PROCEDURES

To access the FAO Headquarters, proceed to the FAO main entrance at Viale Aventino (in front of the Metro “Circo Massimo” Exit), a valid ID (no digital copies), and the FAO pass are required.

The FAO passes will be handled to you by the CWMUN Staff at the entrance.

IMPORTANT: For security reasons, you will not be admitted inside the FAOHQ without your pass. **It is not possible to replace it in case it gets lost.**

Please follow the line outside the building and the indications given by the FAO and CWMUN Staff.

It is strictly forbidden to enter food and beverages inside the FAOHQ.

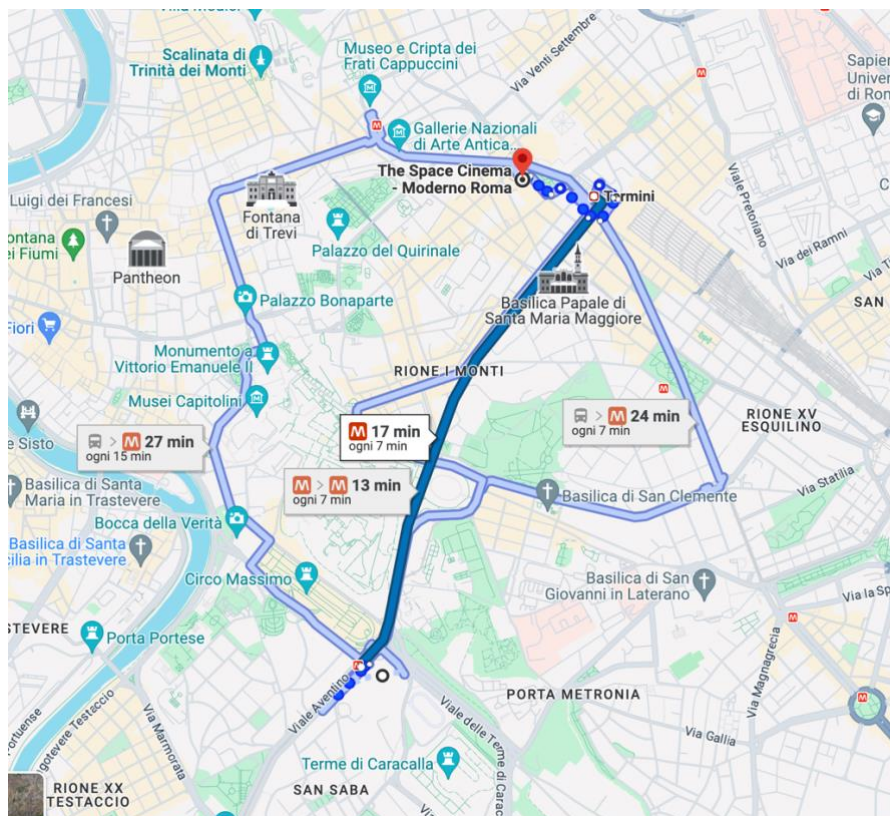

HOW TO GET FROM FAO HQ TO CINEMA MODERNO

To get from FAO (Food and Agriculture Organization) headquarters to Piazza della Repubblica in Rome, you can use public transportation.

Here are the steps for using public transportation

- 1. Walk to the nearest metro station – Circo Massimo:**
FAO headquarters is located near the Circo Massimo metro station (https://maps.app.goo.gl/MCULLZR7fzg6gLGZA?g_st=iw)
- 2. Take Metro Line B (Blue Line):**
Board Metro Line B (direction IONIO/Rebibbia) at Circo Massimo station.
- 3. Get off at Termini Station:**
Piazza della Repubblica is close to Termini Station. Once you arrive at Termini Station, exit the station on Piazza del Cinquecento and walk toward Saint John Paul II statue.
- 4. Walk to Piazza della Repubblica:**
The Piazza is within walking distance from Termini Station. Follow the streets and signs to reach Piazza della Repubblica.



GENERAL INFO FOR THE CONFERENCE DAYS

○ **FOOD AND BEVERAGE**

No food or beverage is allowed in any of the conference rooms. Any student found guilty will be **fined 20€** to cover all the cleaning costs.

○ **PLACARDS**

Delegates will receive, for the first committee day, their placards directly in committee during the "Roll Call". Each delegation will receive one placard and will be considered responsible for it. For this reason, at the end of the first conference day, all delegates will have to take their placard with them. In case of loss, the delegation will be charged **€20 fee** to receive a re-printed placard.

○ **NAME BADGES**

Name Badges are mandatory during every committee session. **No delegate will be admitted to the committee without it.** For security reasons, in case of loss, the delegate will be charged **€50 fee** to receive a re-printed CWMUN name badge.

○ **DRESS CODE**

Formal western business attire is required.

○ **GENERAL BEHAVIOUR**
